#### **Market Overview**

- Nifty50 shed all gains from yesterday session. Broader indices including Nifty Midcap100 and Nifty Smallcap100 ended lower by -0.32% and -0.17% respectively.
- India VIX ended lower by -0.23% by 0.03 points to close at 12.97;
- Advance-Decline Ratio on NSE ended at 0.72 indicating more number of companies declined as against advancing. Overall out of 2736 Nifty companies 943 - Advances, 1308 - Declines and 485 - Unchanged.
- Sectorally, all indices ended in red except realty sector. Macrotech Developers gained 18% in today session amid premium housing demand.
- Total Equities traded value fell to Rs. 54,033.12 vs Rs. 43,957.43 crore in last session.
- Reliance, Tata Power in race for \$2.4 billion solar module incentive.
- **Derivative to Cash Ratio stood at 2.45** indicating higher amount of trades taken in derivatives (including Options and Futures) as against cash market. Source: NSE, BSE, RBI

#### **Market Outlook**

- Nifty again fell to bearish zone. Currently, Nifty index doesn't seem to have any definite pattern and it is better to stay away for while.
- Bank Nifty failed to retain 40,400 levels and we feel it may trend lower.
- Premium housing segment would see uptick in demand till 31st March.

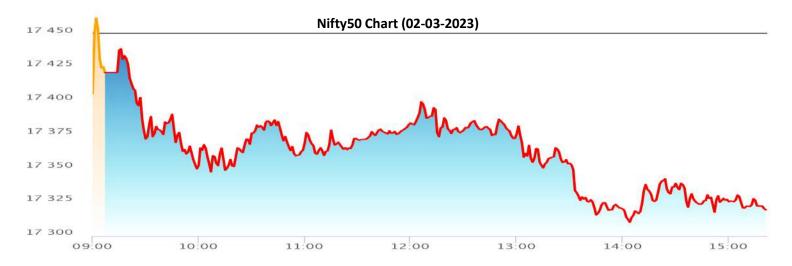
