Market Overview

- Nifty50 closed above 17,660 levels indicating bullishness is still on in market.
 Nifty Midcap100 and Nifty Smallcap100 ended flat by -0.09% and -0.10% respectively.
- India VIX ended higher by 0.58% rising 0.07 points to close at 12.15;
- Advance-Decline Ratio on NSE ended at 0.91 indicating less number of companies advanced as against declining.
- Sectorally: IT and Media dragged market on downside. IT falling consecutively after TCS, Infy results.
- Total Equities traded value decreased to Rs. 48,805* vs. Rs. 51,314.47 crore in previous trading session.
- Derivative to Cash Ratio stood at 2.54* indicating higher amount of trades taken in derivatives (including Options and Futures) as against cash market.

- Zydus Life sciences hits 52 week high on USFDA approval for osteoporosis drug.


